TO-AND-FRO BRITAIN & BRITANNY

In a partnership with the Grayhound Lugger, TransOceanic Wind Transport (TOWT) launches a steady transport cargo route between Brittany and Devon/ Cornwall. Inspired by the historical routes “Muscadet” and “Johnnies”, the Grayhound Lugger will cross the Channel five times in 2015.

Each product shipped by the Grayhound Lugger is identified by the eco-label “Transporté à la voile - Shipped by sail power” which contains a code linking to all the navigational information about the crossings, especially the reduction of CO2 emissions.
